



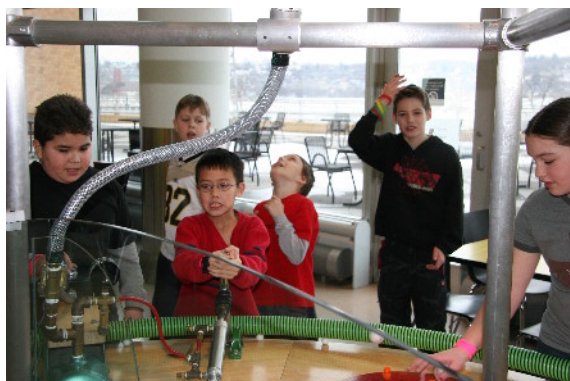

On Saturday, January 20 we will be taking our annual trip to the Science Museum of Minnesota.

Parents, bring your children to the church parking lot across Chicago Avenue from First Free, which is 5150 Chicago Avenue, before 9:00 am.

We will bring them back to their houses between 5:00 and 6:00 pm. If you want them dropped off at another location, let us know. You are required by law to take them back, however.



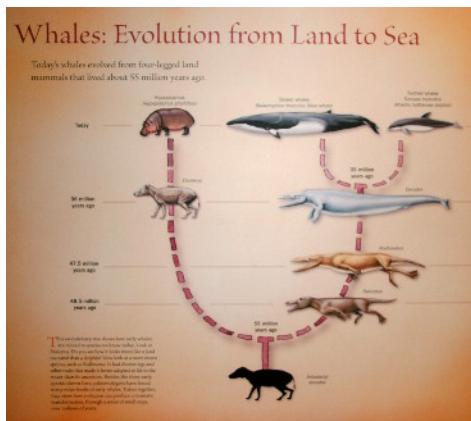
This is a more expensive trip than our hikes because we cannot bring our own food into the Museum. We will collect \$10 for the subsidized cost of admission, Omnitheater (“Vikings”) and 3D Movie (“Elephants”). If you have a family membership and send the card, your child will be admitted free.

Also send about \$5.00 for food. We will eat lunch at about 12:00 noon. There are burger meals, hot dog meals, pizza meals and some others available at the cafeteria that sell in the range of \$4.00 and there are snacks

available at 2 snack bars. Make sure your child remembers that when the money is gone, it is really gone. Also, some kids want to buy things in the museum store at the end of the day and if they have your permission, remind them not to eat all their money.



The museum has a mix of true scientific and technological information and evolutionary propaganda. We discuss the various exhibits as we go. There is a new exhibit on race which is good. After all, we are all related to Noah.



This event is open basically to those children who attend Sunday Junior Church, unlike the Spring and Fall Hikes which are open to a much wider group. There is a possibility of allowing a few invited friends, but check with us first before making arrangements.
